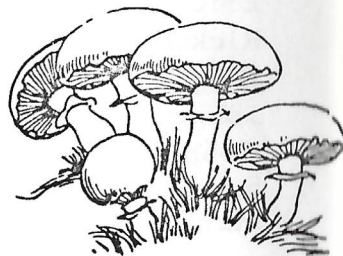


# I Ran Away Today

the dry land.

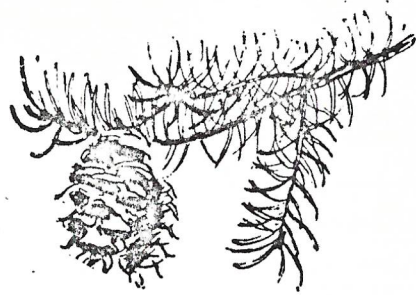
### 6. GOING HOME
